In February 2024, the Center for Quality Management and Accreditation conducted an anonymous electronic survey "Satisfaction of master students with educational services".

The purpose of the study is to measure consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the University.

The subject of the study is the formed ideas of master students about organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the survey were processed and presented in a generalized form with a guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of master's students.

The object of the study is the 1 and 2 year master students.


19 respondents took part in the survey, which amounted to 82.6% of the total number of master students.
















12.3 Availability of technology, computers needed for the for master students' educational process and scientific activities







The following conclusions can be drawn from the survey results:

- 1. The main factors determining the choice of studying in a master's program at the University:
- the location of the University in the same locality where the family lives or close to it was taken into account by 32.4% of master students;
- the possibility of easy employment with a diploma from this University was important for 30.7% of master students;
- the high quality of education at the University was rated as a decisive factor by 26.2% of master students. In addition, it is worth considering that the availability of budget places and a large selection of specialties also influence the decision to enter a master program at a university.
- 2. The average level of satisfaction with the availability of information of the field of study of master students is 81.8%. This is a high level of satisfaction, which indicates that most master students consider the information on their field of study to be accessible and satisfactory. Good availability of information helps master students to more effectively plan their educational activities, navigate the educational process and successfully master the educational material.
- 3. The teaching staff of the master's program is highly rated by master students. According to key indicators such as level of knowledge and professionalism, objectivity, pedagogical skills and teaching methods, more than 91% of survey participants gave ratings of "very high" and "high".

- 4. Participation of master students in developing an individual working plan:
- 43.2% of master students actively participate in developing their work plan under the supervision of their supervisor, which indicates a high degree of independence and responsibility of master students;
- 19.9% of master students develop a plan independently, and the supervisor signs it without exerting significant influence;
- 32.4% of master students see their participation as formal, since they relied more on the help of the supervisor due to difficulties in independently formulating ideas;
- 4.5% of master students do not participate at all, however, self-critically assessing their efforts, they believe that they could not have coped without the main help of their supervisor.
- 5. Satisfaction with the help of the supervisor in preparing the master's thesis: 78.4% of master students are completely satisfied and 21.6% are partially satisfied with the help provided to them by their supervisor. This is an indicator of a high level of satisfaction of master students with the quality and support received from their supervisor.
 - 6. Indicators of the high scientific level of the University:
- the involvement of master students in research projects (51.2%) indicates the active scientific activity of master students;
- the competent teaching staff (27.9%) contributes to high-quality educational and scientific activities;
- the updated material and technical base (23.3%) has a significant impact on the quality of scientific research and the training of master's degree students;
- the work of famous foreign scientists at the University (21.6%) contributes to the exchange of experience, the development of scientific ties and the attraction of international projects;
- the University participation in the development of target programs for the socio-economic development of the region, cities, enterprises (15.4%) indicates its significant role in the socio-economic development of society.
- 7. Participation of master's degree students in research projects and scientific life of the university: 78.6% of master's degree students actively participate in research projects and attend scientific events, such as seminars and conferences. These data show that most master's degree students are involved in scientific activities, which contributes to their academic and professional development.
- 8. Publication of scientific papers: over the entire period of their activity, 87.5% of master's degree students published their theses and articles in both Kazakhstan and foreign publications. This indicates a high level of involvement of master students in the scientific community and their desire to disseminate the results of their research internationally. This level of activity facilitates the exchange of knowledge and experience, and also increases their professional status in the academic environment.
- 9. Foreign language proficiency: the majority of master's degree students (71%) have different levels of foreign language proficiency, from basic with the use of a dictionary to complete freedom in expression. However, there are those who do not speak a foreign language at all, which may create certain difficulties in learning and communication. Efforts to improve knowledge of a foreign language can be useful both in the academic and professional activities of master's degree students.
- 10. Satisfaction of master's degree students with the quality of educational services: 90.9% of respondents expressed satisfaction with the organization of the educational process and industrial practice, 89.2% with organization of free time, 84.7% with organization of catering, and 78.4% with the living conditions in the hostel. These data indicate the good quality of

services and support provided by the University to ensure successful learning and comfort of master's degree students.

In general, master's degree students highly value the research and teaching opportunities provided by the University, which is reflected in the satisfaction of master's degree students.

Recommendations:

The head of the department should familiarize and discuss the results of the survey with the staff and master students, if necessary, to develop an action plan to improve the quality of educational services.
