In February 2024, the Center of Quality Management and Accreditation conducted a survey on Doctoral students' satisfaction with educational services.

The purpose of the study is to measure consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the University.

The subject of the study is doctoral students' ideas about organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the survey were processed and presented in a generalized form with the guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of doctoral students.

The object of the study is the 1st to 3rd year doctoral students.

In the survey, there took part 21 respondents; this amounted to 100% of the total number of doctoral students.





Based on the survey results, the following conclusions can be drawn:

The analysis of the survey results shows that doctoral students are satisfied with the educational services.

The overwhelming majority of doctoral students (93.3%) are satisfied with the relevance of the dissertation topics that correspond to their research interests. The survey also showed that they highly (93.3%) rate the professionalism and competence of their academic supervisors; organizational, methodological and informational support in preparing dissertations; access to participation in departmental research projects, including funded ones; as well as the University prompt response to their requests.

93% of doctoral students are satisfied with the possibilities of testing and publishing the results of their dissertation research. This indicates that the university provides doctoral students with sufficient opportunities to disseminate their research results and promotes their professional development.

Availability, completeness and reliability of information about scientific events held at the University and outside it are assessed by respondents at 93.3%. Doctoral students also rated the organization and conduct of foreign internships well, as well as their effectiveness. 90% of respondents expressed satisfaction with these aspects. This indicates that the University effectively organizes and conducts foreign internships, providing doctoral students with valuable and productive experience, indicating the achievement of the set goals and the acquisition of significant knowledge and skills by doctoral students.

The professional skills of domestic consultants in the field of research were assessed by doctoral students at a high level. The ability to publish research as a lead author, collaboration, determination of methodology and compliance with ethics received the highest rating (100%), while other skills, such as international reputation, contribution to science, development of research programs received collaboration, were rated at 93.3%.

Satisfaction of doctoral students with the professional skills of their overseas advisor in the field of research is on average 98%. The overseas advisor provides high-quality support and guidance to doctoral students, helping them to develop their research skills, expand their knowledge and achieve success in their projects. Overall, doctoral students are very satisfied with the professionalism and commitment of the advisor.

Opportunities that doctoral students attach great importance to in their work are as follows:

- receiving a high salary (93.3%);
- career advancement (93.3%);
- professional development (88.6%);
- contribution to science (88.6%);
- collaboration with highly competent colleagues (81.9%);
- creation of prestige in the professional field (81.9%);

- work under a highly competent manager (81.9%);
- development of own ideas (80%);
- engaging in prestigious activities (77.1%);
- comfortable working conditions (77.1%).

The level of availability of the University material and technical resources is assessed as satisfactory. Library funds, equipment and computers for the educational process and research activities, Internet, food, sports equipment and living conditions in the dormitory meet the requirements and expectations of students.

To the question "Do you plan to defend your dissertation by the end of your studies?" 81.9% of respondents chose the answer "Yes".

Slightly less than half of the respondents (49.5%) expressed interest in teaching. A significant number of respondents (22.9%) plan to continue their careers as researchers after completing their doctoral studies. A smaller number of respondents (9.5%) intend to work as specialists in the profile of their dissertation outside of academia. About 18% of respondents have not yet decided on their plans for the future.

Overall, respondents rated their satisfaction with their studies (work on their dissertation) in doctoral studies highly.

Recommendations:

The head of the department must familiarize and discuss the survey results with the staff and doctoral students; if necessary, to develop an action plan to improve the quality of educational services.
