Report on the results of the questionnaire

"Satisfaction of doctoral students with educational services" for the 2022-2023 academic year in the educational program

8D07103 "Electric Power Engineering"

In February 2023, the center for quality management and accreditation conducted a questionnaire "Satisfaction of doctoral students with educational services".

The purpose of the study – measuring consumer satisfaction with the quality of university services provided.

The subject of the study: formed ideas of doctoral students about the organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the questionnaire were processed and presented in a summarized form with a guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of doctoral students.

An object research - doctoral students of 1-3 years.

This extensive questionnaire is conducted once every 5 years.

13 respondents took part in the questionnaire, which amounted to 86,7% of the total number of doctoral students.



According to the results of the questionnaire, the following **conclusions** can be drawn:

In general, the results of the questionnaire indicate that doctoral students are satisfied with the educational services of the university.

The relevance of the presented dissertation research topics corresponds to the scientific interests of doctoral students, the satisfaction of doctoral students amounted to -100%.

The respondents' answers confirmed quite expected interdependence of the assessment of professionalism and competence of scientific supervisors and the levels of organizational, methodological and informational support of dissertation research preparation. Information resources provided by the university in the areas of doctoral students' training are generally sufficient and available for the preparation of dissertation research - 100% of doctoral students are satisfied.

Opportunities for approbation and publication of the results of the dissertation research satisfaction was 100%.

The availability, completeness and reliability of information about scientific events held at the University and outside it is assessed by respondents at 100%.

From the point of view of doctoral students, the overall level of organization and conduct of foreign internships is at a satisfied level -94,4%. The performance level of overseas internship satisfaction was 94.4%, but 5.6% found it difficult to answer.

For the options "Other" and "If you answered "not satisfied or completely unsatisfied" to the previous question, respondents indicated the following options ответов: "There was no internship yet", "No" and "The issues of foreign scientific internship should be solved at the level of university supervisors. A doctoral student is not the person who should be engaged in organizational work. The department assists in formalizing the internship, but in my opinion, this is not their task either. There is a need for a special person who will organize and supervise the scientific internships of doctoral students".

In the question "Assess the professional skills of a domestic consultant in the field of research" the following information was obtained:

- "Demonstrates the ability to propose the development, implementation and adaptation of a holistic research program" doctoral students' satisfaction was 100%;
- "Makes a contribution to science with his/her research as reflected in cited national or international publications or patents" doctoral student satisfaction was 100%;
- "Has an international reputation in his/her research field, has contacts in scientific communities, is able to present and interpret research results" doctoral students' satisfaction was 100%;
- "Makes a positive contribution to the development of scientific knowledge through cooperation and collaboration with other scientists, including foreign" satisfaction of doctoral students amounted to 100%:
- "Publishes papers as a lead author-researcher, conducts scientific seminars and leads sections at conferences" doctoral students' satisfaction was 100%;
- "Identifies acceptable research methodology, research techniques and approaches" doctoral student satisfaction was 100%:
- "Adheres to standards of academic integrity and ethics in research and interpersonal communication" doctoral student satisfaction was 100%.

Also doctoral students are satisfied with the work of the foreign advisor: doctoral students receive advice on the research topic, practical advice and recommendations on the plan and content of the doctoral student's dissertation.

On the question "Are you satisfied with the level of availability of material and technical resources of the university" the following information was received:

- "Library collections" satisfaction of doctoral students amounted to 100%;
- "Technology, computers necessary for the educational process and scientific activity" satisfaction of doctoral students was 100%;
 - "The width of the Internet channel, speed" satisfaction of doctoral students was 100%;
 - "Organization of meals" satisfaction of doctoral students was 100%;
- "Availability and condition of sports equipment" satisfaction of doctoral students amounted to 100%:
 - "Living conditions in the dormitory" satisfaction of doctoral students amounted to 94,4%;

To the question "Do you plan to defend your dissertation by the end of the term of study?" the answers of the respondents were distributed as follows: 91.7% chose the option "Yes" and 8.3% found it difficult to answer.

To the question "What do you plan to work after finishing doctoral studies?" 44.4% would prefer to work as researchers, 19.4% of doctoral students would like to try teaching, 11.1% would like to work as a specialist in the dissertation profile, not related to science and education, 8.3% would like to work as a specialist in another profile and 16.7% found it difficult to answer.

In general, respondents highly rated satisfaction with their studies (work on the dissertation) in doctoral studies.

Recommendations::

1. The head of the department, SID, PO will familiarize themselves with the results of the questionnaire and, if necessary, develop an action plan to improve the quality of educational services.
