In February 2024, the Center of Quality Management and Accreditation conducted a survey on Doctoral students' satisfaction with educational services.

The purpose of the study is to measure consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the University.

The subject of the study is doctoral students' ideas about organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the survey were processed and presented in a generalized form with the guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of doctoral students.

The object of the study is the 1st to 3rd year doctoral students.

In the survey, there took part 21 respondents; this amounted to 100% of the total number of doctoral students.





5.3 Internet channel width, its speed





Based on the survey results, the following conclusions can be drawn:

The analysis of the survey results shows that doctoral students are satisfied with the educational services.

Doctoral students are 100% satisfied with the relevance of the dissertation topics that correspond to their research interests. The survey also showed that doctoral students highly value the professionalism and competence of their scientific supervisors (100%), as well as organizational, methodological and informational support in preparing dissertations (100%).

94.4% of doctoral students are satisfied with the possibilities of testing and publishing the results of their dissertation research. This indicates that the university provides doctoral students with sufficient opportunities to disseminate their research results and promotes their professional development.

The vast majority of doctoral students (94.4%) have the opportunity to participate in the department's research projects, including funded projects. Funded projects provide doctoral students with the necessary resources to conduct high-quality research and achieve significant results.

94.4% of doctoral students are satisfied with the University responsiveness to their requests. This indicates that the University prioritizes timely and effective resolution of doctoral students' problems and requests.

94.4% of respondents rated availability, completeness, and reliability of the information of scientific events held at the University and beyond as high. Doctoral

students also highly rated the organization and conduct of foreign internships, as well as their effectiveness. 95.2% of respondents expressed satisfaction with these aspects. This indicates that the university effectively organizes and conducts foreign internships, providing doctoral students with valuable and productive experience, indicating the achievement of goals and the acquisition of significant knowledge and skills by doctoral students. The professional skills of domestic consultants in the field of research were assessed by doctoral students at a very high level. All seven criteria, including the development and implementation of the research program, scientific contribution, collaboration, international reputation, compliance with the norms of academic integrity and ethics, the ability to publish research as a lead author and determination of methodology, satisfied the respondents by 100%.

The average satisfaction of doctoral students with the professional skills of their overseas advisor in the field of research is 98.9%. The overseas advisor provides high-quality support and guidance to doctoral students, helping them to develop their research skills, expand their knowledge and achieve success in their projects. Overall, doctoral students are very satisfied with the professionalism and commitment of the advisor.

The opportunities that doctoral students attach great importance to in their work are as follows:

- continuing education (95.8%);
- collaboration with highly competent colleagues (95.8%);
- contribution to science (91.1%);
- creating prestige in the professional field (91.1%);
- receiving a high salary (86.9%);
- engaging in prestigious work (85.5%);
- working under a highly competent manager (85.5%);
- comfortable working conditions (85.5%);
- developing own ideas (81.1%);
- career advancement (80%).

The level of availability of the University material and technical resources is assessed as satisfactory. Library collections, equipment and computers for the educational process and scientific activities, Internet, catering, sports equipment and living conditions in the dormitory meet the requirements and expectations of students.

To the question "Do you plan to defend your dissertation by the end of your studies?" 89.7% of respondents gave the positive answer.

More than half of the respondents (51.8%) plan to continue their careers as researchers after completing their doctoral studies. A significant number of respondents (25.4%) also expressed interest in teaching. A smaller number of respondents (9.7%) intend to work as specialists in the field of their dissertation outside of academia, and 4.2% plan to work in other fields. About 9% of respondents have not yet decided on their plans for the future.

Overall, respondents rated their satisfaction with their studies (work on the dissertation) as highly.

Recommendations:

The head of the department must familiarize and discuss the survey results with the staff and doctoral students; if necessary, to develop an action plan to improve the quality of educational services.
