Report on the results of the questionnaire "Satisfaction of master students with educational services" for the 2022-2023 academic year in the educational program 7M11201 "Life safety and environmental protection"

In February 2023, the Center for Quality Management and Accreditation conducted an anonymous electronic questionnaire "Satisfaction master's students with educational services".

The purpose of the study – measuring consumer satisfaction with the quality of university services provided.

The subject of the study: formed ideas of master's students about the organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the questionnaire were processed and presented in a summarized form with a guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of master's students.

An object research - master students of 1-2 years.

This extensive questionnaire is conducted once every 5 years.

The questionnaire was attended by:

1st - 0 master's students;

2nd year - 6 respondents, which amounted to 75% of the total number of master's students.







Based on the results of the survey, the following conclusions can be drawn:

Master's study is a conscious choice of an adult person, which is not influenced by parents or situation, obtaining professional competencies in accordance with the chosen specialty, the next educational stage after bachelor's degree. To the question **"What determined your choice of studying at a university master's program? (choose 3-4 answer options)"** the majority of undergraduates 50% indicated "The prestige of the university", 33,3% - "The university where I studied at the bachelor's degree". Also, master students noted such options as: "Opportunity during studies to pass internships abroad" - 33.3%.

To the question **"How satisfied are you with the availability of information provided by the university in your field of study**" the following information was received:

- "About the training profile" Master's students' satisfaction was 100%,

- "Characteristics of a master's student's professional activity" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 50%, "partially satisfied" - 50%.

- "List of developed competencies of master's degree graduates" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied"- 83,3%, "partially satisfied" - 16,6%.

- "List of master's students' practice databases" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 66,6%, "partially satisfied" - 33,3%.

- "Information about scientific supervisors" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 33,3%, "partially satisfied" - 66,6%.

The teaching staff is rated quite highly by the respondents For all criteria presented in the questionnaire (knowledge, qualifications, objectivity, methodological skill), more than 100% of respondents gave "very high" and "high" marks.

In general, master's students are satisfied with participation in the formation of an individual work plan. According to the obtained data, 83.3% of respondents develop all sections of the plan independently under the control of their supervisor. There are also respondents who participate purely formally in the formation of individual work plans of master students. Probably, scientific supervisors of master's programs should pay attention to planning of cognitive and research activities of master's students with their more active participation.

To the question: **"Rate your satisfaction with the help of your supervisor in preparing your master's thesis"** 50% of respondents chose the option "completely satisfied", and 50% "partially satisfied".

When answering the question "What, in your opinion, is an indicator of a high scientific level of a university? (select 3-4 key characteristics)" 50% of respondents chose the option "modern material and technical base", 33.3% chose "involvement of master students in research projects".

Publication of scientific articles, theses is one of the main conditions for successful start of scientific work for Master students. Published articles and theses, their quantity and quality determine the master's ability to work independently with large amounts of information, to organize scientific activity, to apply methods in the work, to obtain results, to form correct conclusions, to comply with the requirements for the general design and content of scientific papers. Master's students publish their articles and theses both in Kazakhstani editions and far/close foreign editions (66.6%). "Only in Kazakhstan editions" -33.3%.

On the question "**Your level of foreign language proficiency:**" the answers of respondents were distributed as follows: "With a dictionary" - 33.3%, "I speak fluently" - 66.6%.

To the question "Are you satisfied with the scientific and educational environment of the university during your master's studies"? the following information was received:

- "Organization of conferences, round tables, forums at the university, with the participation of master students" master's students' satisfaction was "completely satisfied" - 66,6%, "partially satisfied" - 33,3%.

- "Material and technical support for applied scientific research" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 83,3%, "partially satisfied" - 16,6%.

- "Availability for master students of technology, computers necessary for the educational process and scientific activities" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 66,6% и "partially satisfied" - 33,3%.

- "General level of organization and conduct of foreign internships" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 50%, "partially satisfied" - 50%.

- "Accessibility of library collections, electronic databases and Internet resources" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 83,3%, "partially satisfied"- 16,6%.

- "Availability of scientific equipment, tools, materials" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 50%, "partially satisfied" - 33,3%, "not satisfied" - 16,6%.

- "Availability of laboratories, specialized facilities and experimental sites" master's students' satisfaction was: "completely satisfied" - 33,3%, "partially satisfied" - 66,6%.

In general, the respondents haven't difficulties when studying at the master's program. At the end of the questionnaire it was proposed to include questions that, in the opinion of students, should be added to this questionnaire to improve the training program, improve the quality of services and other areas of the university.

Recommendations:

- The head of the department, SID, PO will familiarize themselves with the results of the questionnaire and, if necessary, develop an action plan to improve the quality of services provided.
