In February 2024, the Center of Quality Management and Accreditation conducted a survey on Doctoral students' satisfaction with educational services.

The purpose of the study is to measure consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the University.

The subject of the study is doctoral students' ideas about organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the survey were processed and presented in a generalized form with the guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of doctoral students.

The object of the study is the 1st to 3rd year doctoral students.

In the survey, there took part 12 respondents; this amounted to 100% of the total number of doctoral students.

The following conclusions can be drawn from the survey results.

The analysis of the survey results shows that doctoral students are satisfied with the educational services.

Doctoral students are 100% satisfied with the relevance of the dissertation topics that correspond to their research interests. The survey also showed that they rate the professionalism and competence of their scientific supervisors very highly (100%); organizational, methodological and informational support in the preparation of dissertations; as well as the University responsiveness to their requests.

The opportunities for testing and publishing the results of dissertation research satisfy all the doctoral students (100%). This indicates that the University provides doctoral students with sufficient opportunities to disseminate their research results and promotes their professional development.

The overwhelming majority of doctoral students (91.7%) have the opportunity to participate in the departmental research projects, including funded projects. Funded projects provide doctoral students with the necessary resources to conduct high-quality research and achieve significant results.

Availability, completeness and reliability of the information of scientific events held at the University and beyond are rated by respondents at 100%. Doctoral students also highly (100%) rated the organization and conduct of foreign internships, as well as their effectiveness. This indicates that the University effectively organizes and conducts foreign internships, providing doctoral students with valuable and productive experience, indicating the achievement of the set goals and the acquisition of significant knowledge and skills by doctoral students.

The professional skills of domestic consultants in the field of research were rated by doctoral students at a very high level. All seven criteria, including the development and implementation of the research program, scientific contribution, cooperation, international reputation, compliance with the standards of academic integrity and ethics, the ability to publish research as a lead author and determination of the methodology, satisfied the respondents by 100%.

The doctoral students' satisfaction with the professional skills of the foreign consultant in the field of research is 100%. The overseas advisor provides high-quality support and guidance to PhD students, helping them to develop their research skills, expand their knowledge and achieve success in their projects. Overall, PhD students are very satisfied with the professionalism and commitment of the advisor.

The opportunities that doctoral students attach great importance to in their work are as follows:

- advanced training (91.7%);
- collaboration with highly competent colleagues (91.7%);
- contribution to science (83.3%);
- comfortable working conditions (83.3%);
- receiving a high salary (83.3%);
- developing one's own ideas (83.3%);
- engaging in prestigious activities (75%);
- working under a highly competent manager (75%);
- career advancement (75%);

- providing prestige in the professional sphere (66.7%).

The level of availability of material and technical resources of the University is assessed as satisfactory. Library funds, equipment and computers for the educational process and scientific activities, Internet, food, sports equipment and living conditions in the dormitory meet the requirements and expectations of students.

To the question "Do you plan to defend your dissertation by the end of your studies?" 100% of respondents chose the answer "Yes".

Half of the respondents (50%) expressed interest in teaching. 16.7% of them plan to continue their careers as researchers after completing their doctoral studies. The other 16.7% intend to work as specialists in the field of their dissertation outside of academia, and 8.3% plan to work in other fields. About 8% of respondents have not yet decided on their plans for the future.

Overall, respondents rated highly their satisfaction with their studies (work at their dissertation) in doctoral studies.

Recommendations:

The head of the department must familiarize and discuss the survey results with the staff and doctoral students; if necessary, to develop an action plan to improve the quality of educational services.
